

New: EFPP Research Award

The promotion of research is one of the main objectives of the EFPP. Being aware of the various results in the field of psychoanalytic psychotherapy research is fundamental for the political impact of our profession. We want to enhance the exchange between clinicians and researchers in our member organisations by granting an award of €2000 for papers or books in the field of psychoanalytic psychotherapy. The EFPP Research Award will be granted every two years during the EFPP Delegates Meeting.

The four sections of the EFPP – adult individual, child and adolescent, group and psychoanalytic family and couple psychotherapy – are invited to participate and send contributions for the EFPP Research Award.
